IDENTIFY

Easily identify students who are at the highest risk for receiving a DFWI status.




INVESTIGATE

At-Risk Students

Identifies students who are at risk of failing the course. This is calculated based on a combination of assignment completion, grades, frequency of access, time spent, and page views.

Class Averages

Provides a summary of the class's overall performance.

Student Performance: Provides a visual breakdown of how all students are performing.

- > Succeeding = In the top 75% for all categories
- > Struggling = In the bottom 25% in time spent, page views, frequency of access, and/or assignment completion
- > Failing = In the bottom 25% for all categories

Average Grade: Shows the current average course grade for the entire class.

% Assignment Completion: Shows the percent of assignments completed by the class.

Message Students

Allows messaging students directly from Pinpoint to the student's inbox. Instructors can choose to send a message to an individual or multiple students.

When sending multiple messages, they are always sent as individual messages to each person listed.*

Student List

Lists student names and current grades for all the students, and has a **View Student Report** option.

* Additionally, instructors can quickly populate who to send a message to by selecting:

- At Risk Students:** Students currently at risk of failing
- Students with a C:** Students who have a current grade between 71-79%
- Students below a C:** Students who have below 71% in the course

1. Student Statistics

- This area shows information on
 - > **Grade:** Student's current grade in the course
 - > **Missing:** Number of due assignments the student has not completed
 - > **Late:** Number of due assignments the student completed late
 - > **Activity Compared to Class:** Their participation compared to other students in the class (Participation is based on coursework submission, activity in discussions, completion of assignments, and other activities. Page Views is based on the number of page views in the course.)
 - > **Percent Complete:** The percent of due assignments completed by the student
 - > **Time Spent in Course:** Time in minutes and seconds they have spent in the course

2. Click History

This shows the page, action and date of each page the student visited in the course. This can be helpful in determining if a student accessed assignments on time.

3. Assignment History

This lists the assignments, current grade, and status of completion (on time, missing, late) for the student.

Be proactive about keeping students from falling behind. Identify, monitor, and engage at-risk students and address problems when they are still solvable.
