
Instructor Dashboard

% Assignment Completion: Shows the percent of assignments completed by the class.


 * Additionally, instructors can quickly populate who to send a message to by selecting: At Risk Students: Students currently at risk of failing

1. Student Statistics

This area shows information on

- > Grade: Student's current grade in the course
- > Missing: Number of due assignments the student has not completed
- > Late: Number of due assignments the student completed late
- Activity Compared to Class: Their participation compared to other students in the class (Participation is based on coursework submission, activity in discussions, completion of assignments, and other activities. Page Views is based on the number of page views in the course.)
- > **Percent Complete:** The percent of due assignments completed by the student
- > Time Spent in Course: Time in minutes and seconds they have spent in the course

2. Click History

This shows the page, action and date of each page the student visited in the course. This can be helpful in determining if a student accessed assignments on time.

3. Assignment History

This lists the assignments, current grade, status of completion (on time, missing, late, graded, submitted), and due date for the student.

Be proactive about keeping students from falling behind. Identify, monitor, and engage at-risk students and address problems when they are still solvable.
